ORGANIST'S NOTES

The Voluntary after the service today will be the Fugue in B minor by Johann Georg Albrechtsberger (1736-1809) who was organist at Melk monastery, the Imperial Court and then St. Stephen's cathedral, Vienna. He published a large number of fugues, this one is from Opus 17, the sedately serious subject is mainly in quavers, with semiquaver triplets, these becoming more prominent as the work progresses. During the Communion I shall play Durezza and Consonanze Stravaganti by Giovanni de Macque (1550-1614) of Naples.
