## ORGANIST'S NOTES

The voluntary after the service today will be sonata III in Bb by Pierre Verheyen (1750-1819) who was organist on Ghent and active both in church music and in opera. He left seven pieces including four binary-form sonatas in a manuscript dated 1815 now in Berlin. This lively piece makes much use of oscillating left hand octaves and of the Alberti bass beneath a tuneful right hand writing with runs in thirds or sixths.
