ORGANIST'S NOTES

The Voluntary after the service today will be Sonata III de clarines y cadireta by Ramón Carnicer (1789-1855) who worked in Barcelona and Madrid and also visited Paris and London, where he composed the Chilean national anthem! He wrote much stage and sacred music, and a set of six organ sonatas has survived in MSS from ca 1808-14 when he was in Menorca. This exuberant piece for the trumpet stops and Choir organ is in binary form and includes passages in octaves and the Alberti bass.
