ORGANIST'S NOTES

Today being Whit Sunday, the Voluntary after the service will be the setting of the hymn Veni Creator Spiritus by Samuel Scheidt (1587-1654) who was organist in Halle. Taken from the 3rd volume of his Tablatura Nova of 1624, three verses are set; in the first the melody is treated fugally, in the second it is in the tenor and in the final verse it is in the bass. During the Communion I shall play settings of Komm Heiliger Geist by Zachow and Walther.
