ORGANIST'S NOTES

The voluntary after the service today will be Ricercar 14 Quinti Toni by Christian Erbach (ca 1570-1635), organist in Augsburg who left some 150 pieces in manuscripts. It is based on two subjects, which appear consecutively and are then frequently combined. The first subject consists of only 4 notes, while the second is much longer and makes use of repeated notes.

During the Communion I shall play the setting of the Credo Cardinale from Girolamo Cavazzoni's book of Organ Masses ca 1543.
