Today being Quadragesima (1st Sunday in Lent), the voluntary after the service will be the setting of the hymn *Christe qui Lux es & dies* by Samuel Scheidt (1587-1654) from part 2 of his *Tabulatura Nova* of 1624. In the first three verses the melody is in the treble, followed by verses in the tenor, alto and bass.

During the Communion I shall play the *Credo Cardinalium* by Claudio Merulo (1533-1604), organist at St. Mark's, Venice.
