Anonymous in the source, it is probably by Melchior Schildt (1592-1667), pupil of Sweelinck and organist in Hanover who left a few pieces in MSS.

During the Communion I shall play the Credo from the *Messa Apostolorum* by Andrea Gabriel (ca1520-86), organist of St. Mark's, Venice.
