ORGANIST'S NOTES

The voluntary after the service will be the setting of the hymn Urbs Jerusalem by Jean Titelouze (1563-1633), organist of Rouen cathedral, and who published two volumes, including a set of 12 hymns in 1623 and Magnificats in 1626. Three verses are set, each in four voices, the melody appearing in the bass in semibreves in the first, treated fugally in the second and also in the third at the conclusion of which the imitative writing dissolves into toccata-like sequential figuration.
