## ORGANIST'S NOTES

As today is Trinity Sunday, the Voluntary after the service will be the setting of the hymn O lux beata Trinitas which is anonymous in the manuscript containing some 19 hymn settings, but is almost certainly by Hieronimus Praetorius (1560-1629) who was organist of the Jacobikirche, Hamburg. Two verses are set, in four voices each, the treble being highly ornamented.
