The voluntary after the service today will be a setting of Psalm 23 found in a 17<sup>th</sup> century manuscript now in Berlin. The piece, based on the Genevan melody, is anonymous in the source but attributed by some scholars to Jan Sweelinck (1562 -1621), organist of the Oude Kerk, Amsterdam. In each of the three variations the melody appears in the treble in a highly ornamented form.
