ORGANIST'S NOTES

The voluntary after the service today will be the Tiento no. 13 do 5 Tom natural por b-quadro by Manuel Rodrigues Coelho (ca 1555-1635), organist at Elvas and Lisbon cathedrals, who published a large collection of pieces in 1620 including 24 Tentos or fugal pieces, three on each of the Church Tones. In this piece the main subject is combined with rhythmic and melodic motifs, and the piece concludes with a short triple-time section.

John will be playing an organ recital at St. George's on Friday 6th June at 12:30pm, with proceeds going towards next year's Ashburnham weekend. More details nearer the time.
