The Voluntary after the service today will be Sonata 1 in C by Andrea Lucchesi (1741-1801) who spent much of his life at Bonn. He left about a dozen organ works in manuscripts, this lively, vibrant sonata being in one movement in binary form. During the Communion I shall play Toccata Duodecima from the book of 1615 by Frescobaldi, organist at St. Peter's, Rome.
