ORGANIST'S NOTES

The voluntary after the service will be the Intento in D minor by José Lidón (1742-1827), based on a theme by Joaquín Oxinaga (1719-89); both composers were organists of the Chapel Royal, Madrid, although not at the same time. The theme, in 6/8, employs much use of chromatic writing, either stepwise or through inflected intervals, and modulates to remote keys.
