ORGANIST'S NOTES

The voluntary after the service today will be *Toccata nona del 4 Tono* by **Claudio Merulo** (1533-1604), organist at **St. Mark's Venice** and **Parma**. He published several collections of keyboard music including two volumes of *Toccatas*, this one being taken from the first set of nine in 1598. It opens slowly before dissolving into virtuosic passagework with precisely notated ornamentation passing from hand to hand.
