HOLOCAUST MEMORIAL DAY - Monday 27th January

The day is all about remembering those who were victims of the holocaust and how their lives were brutally changed by Nazi persecution. The date of 27 January was chosen as it is the same date that Aushwitz-Birkenau, the largest Nazi concentration camp, was liberated in 1945. It also acts as a day of remembrance for more recent genocides in places like Cambodia, Rwanda, Bosnia and Darfur. The theme for HMD 2014 is "Journeys". Those affected by the Holocaust and genocide experience journeys, whether it is a journey of persecution, a death march, a journey into hiding or a refugee journey. On the memorial day we can remember those whose lives were changed by learning from these past mistakes and taking part in local events to inform people and remember the importance of standing up against hatred, discrimination and persecution.

The voluntary after the service today will Obra de 7 Tom sobre o Seculorum (world without end cf. Eph 3:21) which is found in a voluminous MS at Braga; although anonymous in the source, this rhythmically varied fugal piece may well be by Pedro de Araújo (ca 1640-1704), leading Portuguese keyboard composer of his time who was organist in Braga.
