STEWARDSHIP SUNDAY at St GEORGE'S

Today we are drawing attention to the gap (deficit) between the cost of running our church and the income we receive which does not cover this expenditure. To help us all review our "Giving" there's suggestions, literature and people to talk with to help us think and decide what is right for each of us.

One of the easiest ways to "Give", that most benefits our church, is by using the Parish Giving Scheme, or weekly envelopes, and Gift Aiding the amount. This will be fully explained in the Service and in leaflets available. Through such schemes a regular income is received week by week and Gift Aiding the amount increases what we give to St Georges by an extra 25p for every £ we give; this is claimed back by the Church from the Inland Revenue.

Although we do not like talking about money matters, it's very important for the present and future ministry at St Georges, so please think and pray about what you can do to help.
