ORGANIST'S NOTES

The voluntary after the service will be the Capriccio sopra Il Cucho by Girolamo Frescobaldi (1583-1643), who was organist of St. Peter's Rome and a major influence on European keyboard music. Taken from a published set of 1624, this multi-sectional piece contains the notes D-B, representing the cuckoo, in the treble line throughout the piece. My colleague Christopher Stembidge recently informed me that, according to a book of 1615 in the Library at Florence, the Cuckoo is a symbol of the Virgin Mary because she gave birth, not in her home town of Nazareth, but in 'someone else's nest' - in Bethlehem, thus making this Capriccio most suitable for Mothering Sunday.
