PRAYER NEEDS

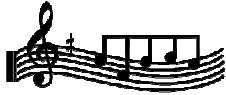

The Voluntary after the service today will be the Sonata in C by Quirino Gasparini (1721-78), who was maestro di capello of Turin cathedral. He composed operas, sacred music and left a few organ pieces. This lively Sonata in binary form features mainly semiquaver figuration in right hand over repeated quavers, or right hand crotchets over an Alberti bass.

SCAM

Please be on your guard for a scam which Sussex police advise has occurred at least 5 times recently in Worthing/Sompting/Lancing areas.

The scam operates as follows:-

1. Caller phones and claims he is from 'The Police'
2. Caller claims he is from the 'Serious Fraud Office'
3. Caller claims a very large (fraudulent) transaction has occurred on your 'card'
4. Caller claims e.g. a very expensive camera or iPad was bought on your card in 'North London'
5. Caller gives you a 'Crime Reference Number'
6. Caller gives a plausible (English) name
7. **Caller asks for your Credit Card/Debit Card number**
8. **Caller asks for your P.I.N**
9. Caller tells you that your Credit Card/Debit Card will be needed by Police in evidence
10. Caller asks that you place your Credit Card/Debit Card in sealed envelope for courier Collection
11. Caller phones back within 30 minutes to confirm your Account Number and PIN number
12. Caller checks a time for your sealed envelope to be courier collected

If you are contacted in this way at all DO NOT give the caller ANY details of your cards. If at all possible contact the police on 101 on an alternative phone line.
