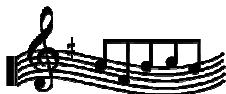

ORGANIST'S NOTES



The Voluntary after the service today will be the *Obra de 1 Tom por B-quadro* (ie with B natural rather than the expected Bb) by Pedro de Araújo ca. 1640-1704, probably organist in Braga, who left a handful of substantial organ works in two MSS. This piece is fugal, and also contains sections based on short motifs. During the Communion I shall play *Elevazione* by Giuseppe Gonelli 1685-1745 of Cremona.

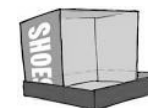
