ORGANIST'S NOTES



The voluntary after the service today will be Toccata Settima dell'8 Tono by Claudio Merulo (1533-1604) who was organist of St. Mark's, Venice and in ducal service at Parma. He left two volumes of Toccatas as well as Ricercars and Canzonas in print, this piece is taken from the second set of Toccatas of 1604. It opens slowly, and contains extended passages of very rapid figuration passed between the hands, which alternate with two fugal sections, which are omitted in the version in the Turin MSS.

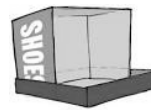
