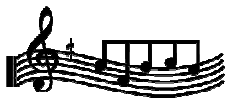


RUNNING MAN

The Voluntary after the service today will be Tiento 67 Partido de dos triples de 6 Tono by Juan Baptista Cabanilles (1644-1712), organist of Valencia cathedral whose pupils copied over 200 large scale works into MS. In this imitative piece the solo stops are for the two upper voices, and the second section switches between 3/2 and 6/4 before a short toccata-like coda.

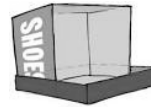
ACORN
