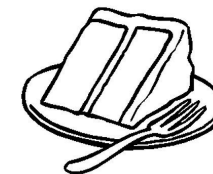


## HARVEST LUNCH

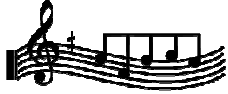

After the service

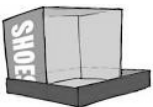

## WILL AID

Every November, Will Aid Solicitors give up their time to write Wills for people in return for a voluntary donation to charity. If you have not already written your Will, the opportunity is coming around again soon. You'll have to hurry though, Will Aid Solicitors tend to get booked up very early.

A Will Aid poll last year showed that nearly half of the people asked thought their estate would go to their partner in the event of their death. In fact, the only way to be absolutely certain that your money and possessions go to the people you want is by having an up-to-date Will.

How Will Aid Works:

- Solicitors across the UK donate their time to support the Will Aid charities.
- Instead of paying a fee for writing a basic Will you will be invited to make a donation to the Will Aid charities.
- Suggested donations are £95 for a single Will or £150 for a pair of mirror Wills.

Every year people miss out on Will Aid by leaving it too late. Will Aid solicitors are in big demand throughout November so the sooner you book, the better.
