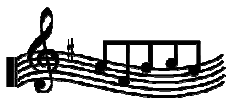

ORGANIST'S NOTES



The Voluntary after the service today will be the Ricercar on the 2nd Tone by Hans Leo Hassler (1564-1612) who studied in Venice and was organist at various courts in Germany. He left a large amount of keyboard music in several manuscripts, this piece being taken from a set now in Turin. It is fugal, with the first subject in longer notes than the second; apart from some cadential flourishes the piece is quite stately.
