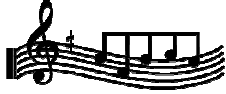

## ORGANIST'S NOTES



The Voluntary after the service today is Sonata XIV de octavo Tono (ie in G major) by Anselmo Viola (1738-98) who was an organist and monk at the monastery of Montserrat. He left a small number of keyboard pieces in manuscripts, most of them being binary form sonatas like this one, which shows the influence of Scarlatti in its rapid textural and thematic changes combined with an essentially Spanish folk idiom.

Every November, Will Aid Solicitors give up their time to write Wills for people in return for a voluntary donation to charity.

A Will Aid poll last year showed that nearly half of the people asked thought their estate would go to their partner in the event of their death. In fact, the only way to be absolutely certain that your money and possessions go to the people you want is by having an up-to-date Will.

How Will Aid Works:

- Solicitors across the UK donate their time to support the Will Aid charities.
  - Instead of paying a fee for writing a basic Will you will be invited to make a donation to the Will Aid charities.
  - Suggested donations are £95 for a single Will or £150 for a pair of mirror Wills.
