The reading set for today tells of the visit of Gabriel to Mary, so the Voluntary after the service will be the setting of the Magnificat on the 2nd Tone by Samuel Scheidt (1587-1654), organist in Halle. Taken from the 3rd part of his Tabulatura Nova of 1624, six verses are set. The first verse treats the chant fugally, then it is heard in the treble, treble, tenor, bass and treble respectively.
