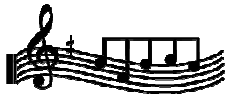
## PRAYER NEEDS

## ORGANIST'S NOTES



The Voluntary after the service today will be the Obra found in a MS of 10 pieces now in Mexico City, and probably by Joseph de Torres (ca.1670-1738), who was a publisher in Madrid and organist of the Royal Chapel, although possibly by a contemporary Mexican composer of the same name. It is a toccata-like piece, with much use of sequential figures and rapid passages showing a pronounced Italian influence.
