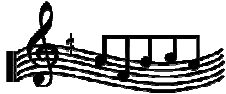

The Voluntary after the service today will be Ricercar Eight on the Eighth Tone with three subjects on the hymn Iste Confessor by Giovanni Salvatore (ca. 1610-75), who published a book of organ pieces in various genres in 1641, when he was organist of San Severino, Naples. The hymn tune appears in each voice, with the other subjects weaving against it.
