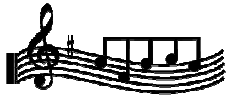

ORGANIST'S NOTES



The voluntary after the service today will be the Fantasia on the 8th Tone by Pieter Cornet (ca. 1570-1633), organist to the Ducal Court in Brussels. Preserved in a manuscript now at Oxford, this piece is in three voices, with virtuoso writing for the left hand, including fast passages and leaps, frequently in sequential patterns.
