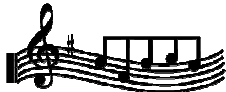

ORGANIST'S NOTES



The voluntary after the service today will be sonata 11 in C by Domenico Puccini (1772-1815), organist of Lucca cathedral and grandfather of the opera composer. He left 42 sonatas for organ in MSS, all of them through-composed, and in a light, tuneful style. This sonata is in the form of a rondo, with two short episodes in the major and two more in the minor between the appearances of the theme. The Communion will be the Unter der Wandlung from the fourth organ mass by Theodor Grunberger (1756-1820). The music today is for Helen, whose birthday was last Friday.
