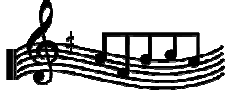
PRAYER NEEDS

ORGANIST'S NOTES



The Voluntary after the service today will be the Fugue in E op.7 no. 6 by Johann Albrechtsberger (1736-1809) who succeeded Mozart as Kapellmeister at Vienna cathedral, and who taught Beethoven composition. He left numerous collections of fugues, this set dating from 1796; this piece is in four voices, with the subject in two parts separated by a rest, each part also treated sequentially as the piece progresses.
