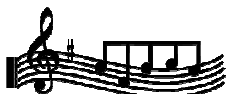

## ORGANIST'S NOTES



The Voluntary after the service will be Ricercar XXXI in G minor by Gottlieb Muffat (1690-1770), organist to the Imperial Court in Vienna. He composed much keyboard music, but relatively little was published. Taken from a manuscript of ca.1730 containing 32 ricercars and 19 canzonas which show a deep awareness of Italian models of the 17th century, this serious yet fluid piece has a subject descending a fourth by semitones, with a short secondary motif in quavers.
