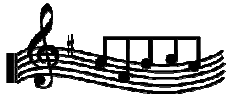

## ORGANIST'S NOTES



As today is Saint David's Day the Voluntary after the service will be the Prelude and Voluntary in A by Thomas Tomkins (1572-1656) who spent most of his working life as organist of Worcester cathedral. He composed much church music and left a large corpus of keyboard music in MSS. The prelude is based on fast passagework for both hands, and the voluntary is imitative with several overlapping subjects. I shall play more of his pieces before the service.
