## ORGANIST'S NOTES



The Voluntary after the service today will be Ricercar Quarto Tono by Andrea Gabrieli (ca. 1532-85), organist at St. Mark's, Venice, who published much vocal music, and a good number of keyboard pieces which were published posthumously by his nephew Giovanni. A serious piece, with several written-out ornaments, the opening section has two main subjects, followed by a triple-time section with several short motifs.

During the Communion I shall play the Elevazione in G minor by G.B.Martini (1706-84).
