## ORGANIST'S NOTES



The Voluntary after the service today will be the *Obra de 1 Tom sobre a Salve Regina* by Pedro de Araujo, ca 1640-1705, who was organist of Braga cathedral, north Portugal. He left a handful of pieces in MSS, this work treating the first line of the melody fugally, then the first three notes only are treated, firstly in semibreves and then in quavers. There are some spicy dissonances in the part writing, and in the final few bars the quavers are divided into 3+3+2, both typical of his style. It is for Lynn, whose birthday is today.
