The Voluntary after the service today will be the Passagagli sopra C by Bernardo Storace, who, according to the preface in his book of 1664, was vicemaestro of the chapel in Messina, Sicily. This piece, with 61 four-bar variations based on the descending scale from C to G, is in three sections, in 3/2, 6/8 and 3/2, becoming increasingly chromatic.
