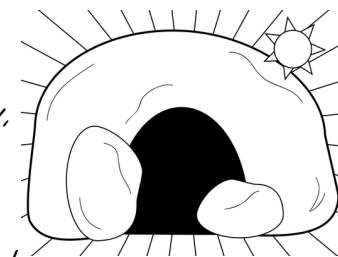

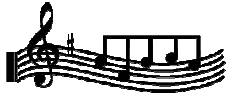

## ORGANIST'S NOTES



The Voluntary after the service today will be the Sonata in C. Terza Maggiore (ie in C major) by Giuseppe Aleotti, of whom all that seems to be known is that a dozen or so pieces were included in a MS of organ sonatas dated 1743 for the use of Giacomo Poffa of Cremona. It is in 2/4 in binary form in a two-voice texture; the left hand moves mainly in quavers beneath a rhythmically varied treble line.

## HUSTINGS

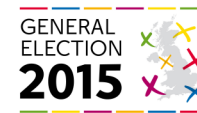
The elections are just around the corner and Adur
