The Voluntary after

the service today will be the Obra de 1 Tom by Fr. Luis Coutinho, which is found in a MS compiled during the 17th century and now in Braga, Portugal. The only known work by this composer, it is fugal and in two sections, its abstract subject being used by other European composers. Both sections contain the typical 3+3+2 quaver groups and the second section makes use of varied countersubjects.
