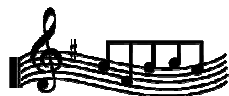

## ORGANIST'S NOTES



The Voluntary after the service today will be the Ricercare and Canzona by Carlotta Ferrari b.1975. The Ricercare is subtitled Durezza e Ligature (Dissonances and Suspensions) and consists of shifting chords with dissonances and suspensions, and the Canzona retains the rhythmic scheme of the early form but again with a modern harmonic language. This piece has been written especially for me by the composer as a thank you for my tireless work in promoting the early Italian repertoire in the UK - a most flattering gesture.

During the Communion I shall play Toccata 12 from book 1 of 1615 by Frescobaldi (1583-1643), written in the Durezza e Ligature style.
