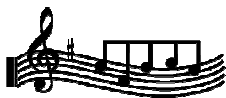

ORGANIST'S NOTES



The Voluntary after the service today will be the Tiento lleno de 6 Tono sobre Ut re mi fa sol fa (ie CDEFGA) by Pablo Bruna, 1611-79, organist of Daroca, who was blind from infancy and left some 30 pieces in MSS. This piece is based on the first six notes of the ascending scale, and is treated fugally, the subject appearing throughout the piece, sometimes in a descending form. It is in five sections, the first, third and final one being in C time, the second being in 3/2, the fourth in 3/2 with each minim subdivided into triplets.
