ORGANIST'S NOTES



Today is Whitsun-

day or Pentecost, so the voluntary after the service today will be the setting of the seasonal hymn Komm, heiliger Geist, Herre Gott, by Friedrich Zachow (1663-1712), organist in Halle and teacher of Handel. Three verses are set, in the first the melody is heard in the treble against two lower parts, the second treats the whole melody fugally and the final verse treats the first line of the melody fugally. Before the service I shall play other settings of the melody from France, Italy and Germany.
