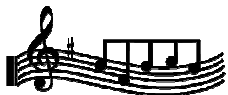

ORGANIST'S NOTES



The Voluntary after the service today will be a setting of the Trinity hymn *Allein Gott in der Hohe sei Ehr* by Johann Pachelbel (1653-1706), who was organist at Erfurt and Nuremberg, and left many keyboard pieces of all genres in MSS. This setting opens with a fugal treatment of the decorated opening line of the melody in semiquavers before the complete melody appears in the bass in minims, against swirling semiquaver figures in the upper voices, some of which are derived from the following of the melody.
