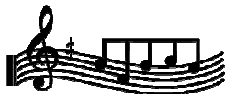

ORGANIST'S NOTES



As this Tuesday will be Sussex Day the Voluntary after the service this morning will be Voluntary 17 in F by John Marsh (1752-1828) who spent much of his life as an organist in Chichester. He published 5 volumes of Voluntaries and 6 of arrangements, as well as a Treatise on playing the organ. Taken from his second collection of ca. 1795, this piece is in two movements, a Largo in 4/4 being followed by a lively Fugue in 3/4.

During the Communion I shall play Toccata Undecima by Frescobaldi (1583-1643) from his 1st book of Toccata etc., 1615.

This afternoon John will be providing background music at Christ Church, Portland Road, between 2-4.30pm. The concert in which he played last Sunday at Heene raised almost £250 for the Nepal relief fund.
