The Voluntary after the service today will be the Registo de 8 Tom de 2 Tiples by Fr. Joseph Torrellas, of whom all that is known are the dozen or so pieces in a manuscript now in Oporto. The two upper voices carry the solo, and the piece is in two sections, a slower opening in C time is followed by a triple-time section with dance-like dotted rhythms, cross-rhythms and even the sound of the cuckoo can be heard!
