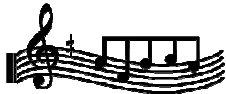

## ORGANIST'S NOTES



The Voluntary after the service this morning will be Toccata Settima from the 1st book of Toccatas by Girolamo Frescobaldi (1583-1643), organist of St. Peter's, Rome and arguably the most important composer for keyboard in the 17th century, his influence being felt across Europe. Published in 1615, the book contains 12 Toccatas and several sets of variations; showing the influence of the Neapolitans, after a slow chordal opening the piece dissolves into a succession of short motifs and virtuoso scale passages, with some harmonies which still amaze today.
