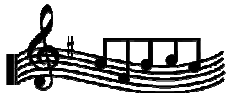

The Voluntary after the service today will be Sonata 39 in D by Domenico Puccini (1772-1815), organist of Lucca cathedral and grandfather of the famous opera composer. He left 42 sonatas for organ in MS, each being in one section without repeats. This one includes mainly melodic right hand passages over either broken arpeggios or repeated notes/chords. It's for Brian Masters, whose birthday is today. During the Communion I shall play the Tiento de Falsas De 6 Tono by Lic. Francisco Vila from the Astorga cathedral MS.

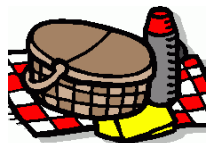
