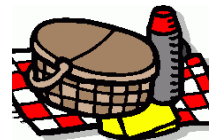
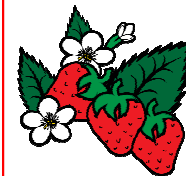

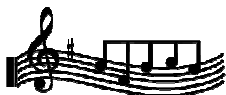

ORGANIST'S NOTES



The Voluntary after the service today will be Tiento 64 Partido de dos tiples de 5 Tono by Juan Baptista Cabanilles (1644-1712), organist of Valencia cathedral and the greatest Spanish composer of keyboard music ever, who left some 200 large-scale pieces. The title tells us that the two upper voices are for the solo stops, with highly virtuosic writing, frequently in thirds, over a slower bass and tenor. The central section is in 12/8.

HEALTH & SAFETY

At a recent PCC meeting the issue was raised of the use now of accident report forms instead of accident books. The current legislation is The Reporting of Injuries, Diseases and Dangerous Occurrences Regulations 20013 (RIDDOR). This is overseen by the Health and Safety Executive (HSE). St George's has a supply of forms kept in the church office for reporting serious accidents or dangerous occurrences. Please contact a Church Warden in the first instance if something occurs which you think should be reported but please use your discretion and common sense over what constitutes a serious accident or dangerous occurrence.
