ORGANIST'S NOTES



The Voluntary after the service today will be the 3rd Tiento on the 8 Tom by Manuel Rodrigues Coelho (a. 155-1625) who was organist at Elvas and Lisbon cathedrals. His publication of 1620 including 24 Tentos and much liturgical material was only the 2nd book for keyboard published in Portugal. The version I shall be playing is, however, taken from a later MS now at Braga; comparison with the printed version reveals some cuts and rhythmic changes. I wish everyone a happy summer, and shall be playing a series of lighter pieces during August.

Organist on tour: John will be playing at festivals at Petworth Parish Church August 15th 11.30-1.30 and at Christ Church, Grafton Road, Worthing on September 5th between 11 and 3pm.

HEALTH & SAFETY

At a recent PCC meeting the issue was raised of the use now of accident report forms instead of accident books. The current legislation is The Reporting of Injuries, Diseases and Dangerous Occurrences Regulations 20013 (RIDDOR). This is overseen by the Health and Safety Executive (HSE). St George's has a supply of forms kept in the church office for reporting serious accidents or dangerous occurrences. Please contact a Church Warden in the first instance if something occurs which you think should be reported but please use your discretion and common sense over what constitutes a serious accident or dangerous occurrence.

St George's is looking to appoint a Health & Safety Officer. If this is an area you have knowledge of and would be willing to take up the position please have a word with one of the Wardens or the Vicar.
