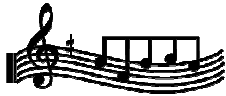
If you would like to be put on to our prayer list, or if a family member or friend is in need of prayer, please contact the office or the Vicar.

ORGANIST'S NOTES



The Voluntary after the service today will be the Registo alto de 6 Tom by Frey Bertolomeu Olague, who lived during the 2nd half of the 17th century and whose 25 or so pieces are found only in a manuscript now in the Porto library. This piece has the solo in the right hand, with much use of sequences, and is in two sections, C time followed by 3/2.

During Communion I shall play the Elevazione in C from an anonymous Messa Piana of the mid 18th century preserved in Montecatini Terme, Tuscany.
