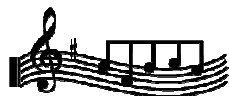

## ORGANIST'S NOTES



The Voluntary after the service today will be the Toccata by Domenico Zipoli (1688-1726) who was organist in Rome until 1716 and then went to Paraguay as a missionary. He published a collection of pieces for organ and harpsichord in 1716, which opens with this Toccata. It commences with chords, continues with sequential semiquaver passages against held chords to another chordal section. Further sequential passages, some based on rhythmic figures, lead to the final section of excitingly virtuosic writing.
