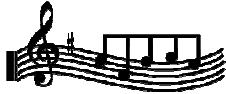

## ORGANIST'S NOTES



The Voluntary after the service today will be the Sonata in F by Tomas Ciurana (1761-1829) who was organist of Santa Maria, Xàtiva, Valencia. He left around 30 sonatas and a dozen Pasos and Fugas. This sonata in 2/4, one of two in the Morella MS, is in binary form, and is mainly in two voices; the second half opens with a chromatic figure in octaves but the writing is predominantly diatonic with melodic figures being repeated.

**Giving to Mission Societies** this year has continued to support work of CPAS, Operation Mobilisation, Tear Fund, Jo Robinson/CMS & Release International as well as a few one off gifts for others.
